

The objectives of Camp Achieve are simple:

To have fun, to build camaraderie and make new friends so each camper knows they are not alone, to have a place where campers can share their experiences and listen to one another's experiences and build strength from them.

Here are a few quotes from kids who attended camp Achieve: "Sitting around the campfire has become a place where we all feel safe to share our feelings openly. To hear others talk about things that they too may struggle with helps us know we are not alone. To be around others who just get it, no explaining, no sighs when it takes a few tries to do something. I have some great friends at home, but there is something very special about being around this group that completes me. I will never be able to thank Shriners for starting these camps and introducing all of us to each other. It is because of you I have made lifelong friends who I will love forever. It was so cool to also hear many other campers say how much we all mean to them and how we are like family. It is true! I will hold these memories in my heart forever." ~ A few campers combined

and assist.


Other Events and Activities that are upcoming:
